

TEMPORARY HOUSE RULES

Approved 4/20/21

MEMBERS

- 1. You and your spouse or co-member (if/as applies) represents a single membership. Per the By-Laws, this includes unmarried dependents of a Regular Member who are residents of the Regular Member's household, who have not yet reached the age of 21 years.
- 2. Due to COVID-19 Guidelines, guest privileges at the club are reduced to two guests per membership number unless otherwise approved by the Commodore or Board of Directors.
- 3. Seating will be subject local and state COVID-19 guidelines.
- 4. The Officer of the Deck will seat your party upon arrival to a table for no more than eight (8) members unless otherwise approved by the Commodore or Board of Directors.
- 5. Members are asked to limit their time to 90-minutes per visit during peak hours when seating is filled. The Officer of the Deck will advise you when it is time to sanitize the table for the next guest(s).
- 6. All members need to show their current membership cards upon entering which will be recorded. Guests may be asked to show their identification cards.
- 7. All members and guests must wear a face covering at all times while in motion except when seated at a table or the bar.
- 8. All members and guests must refrain from closing windows and doors that have been opened for the health and safety of the members and staff.
- 9. All members and guests should adhere to 6 foot social distancing at all times except when seated at a table or the bar.

ANIMALS

Animals are not allowed on Club Facilities at any times without prior permission.

CHILDREN

Children under the age of 21 are to be seated with their parents and be supervised by an adult at all times.

CONDUCT

- 1. DWYC reserves the right to refuse or limit service to anyone for any reason at any time. DWYC further reserves the right to take any reasonable action to enforce these and other applicable rules or laws.
- 2. Bare feet and wet bathing suits are not permitted in the club at any time. After 5:00 p.m., bathing suits, bathing suit cover ups and tank tops for men are not permitted at the club.
- 3. No conduct shall be permitted, which unreasonably interferes with the quiet enjoyment by members or guests or interferes with normal operations of the club, to include but not be limited to vulgarity, abusive language, combative behavior, fighting, yelling, inappropriate attire.

ALCOHOL (ABC)

No alcoholic beverages purchased in the club are allowed beyond the front door or beyond the back doors of the rear patio at any time, except as provided by ABC and local guidelines. No open alcoholic beverages originating from outside the club may be brought onto the club premises at any time.

GUEST DOCK

The primary use of the guest dock is for visiting cruisers from other clubs. The guest dock is available for use to DWYC members on a limited, first come-first serve basis, with approval of the Dock Master. Any DWYC member granted the privilege of using the dock must be available to contact and be prepared to depart immediately if requested to do so by the Dock Master.

RECIPROCALS

Reciprocal hospitality is temporarily revoked until occupancy restrictions are lifted by government agencies unless otherwise approved by the Commodore or the Board of Directors.

VIOLATIONS OF THESE RULES
