HOW IT WORKS To be considered for a Scholarship Award, Students must submit **all** required materials by November 1. Qualifying applicants may receive <u>up to</u> \$2,000.00. The Scholarship Committee will make every effort to distribute funds equitably while retaining a reserve. Award Recipients will be determined by December 31st and Awards distributed within 30 days. Factors considered include overall quality of application, GPA, essay, and qualifying expenses. Decisions of the Scholarship Committee are final.

WHERE DO THESE FUNDS COME FROM The SilverStars (DWYC Staff Commodores) host a number of fundraising events throughout the year exclusively for this purpose. 100% of all net proceeds from these events go into the DWYC SilverStars' Scholarship Fund.

CRITERIA

- Student must be a child or grandchild of a current Regular or Senior DWYC club member who has been a member in good standing for at least one year prior to the Application deadline.
- Student must not have previously received a DWYC Scholarship Award.
- Student must be entering or attending in person a trade school, junior college, undergrad college or university. Enrolled for 12 units minimum, and have paid expenses at that institution. One Application per member per year.

DEADLINE – Student Applicants must provide the following no later than November 1st:

- A completed Application form
- 200 words or less stating why they should receive a DWYC SilverStars' Scholarship Award
- Copies of current Student ID or proof of registration, recent report card (high school if just entering college etc.), class list with units & all Financial aid from other sources.
- Applicable Receipts for books, registration & tuition (Gas, food, living and other personal expense receipts do not qualify)
