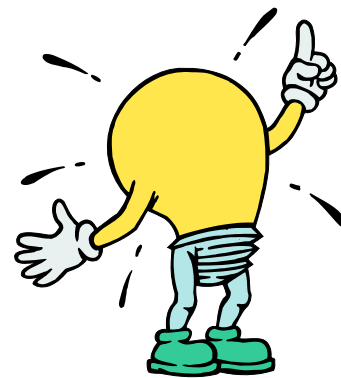
Happy New Year!!

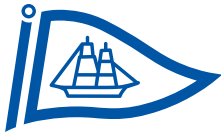
